Fuel Purifier

There ain't nothing that will drive you crazier than dirty fuel. Well, here's a new product that may just end those "dirty fuel blues" once and for all.

The RCI Marine Fuel Purifier, from RCI Purifier West of San Dimas, California, is designed to remove over 99% of all water and up to 98% of dirt, dust, and other normal and natural contaminants found in all types of engine or burner fuel. This system removes the contamination prior to the fuel entering the primary filter system without the use of a replaceable, changeable, or cleanable filter element or cartridge.

The manufacturer tells us that the RCI Purifier is technically a centrifugal separator. As the fuel enters the purifier, it flows through a baffle system causing the fuel to move in a circular movement. This "spinning" fuel is cast against a steel plate, which immediately stops the spinning motion and causes the heavier particles to drop from the fuel stream.

The RCI Marine Fuel Purifier also incorporates a specially designed interior baffle system for rough seas, which prevents water and other separated contaminants from migrating to the outlet. Other features include powder coating of the purifier and all mounting brackets, solid brass fill plug, and UL approved brass drain plug. Stainless steel mounting nuts, bolts and washers are also included.

RCI Marine Fuel Purifiers range in size from .5 gpm fuel flow up to 15 gallons per minute and are designed for all marine applications. If you've got a really big boat, individual units are also available for fuel flows up to 40 gallons, 90 gallons and 200 gallons per minute.
